# FROM THE RANGE

### FOOTWORK! DO YOU HAVE WHAT IT TAKES?

So many times I see people, both when they are trying to gain distance and also when they are right next to the green doing their most to get on the green without using their feet.

Let me explain! Let's start close and then work our way out form the hole. I don't know what it is, but the closer to the hole people are, they stop shifting their weight instead solely on brute force to try to put the ball on the green. It doesn't work that way, especially when using a more lofted club. Because of the additional loft, we need to have more gusto swing with authority while also taking a bigger swing overall.

You ask what would cause this? Both of these things play a part. First, people think they're too close and don't need or have to shift their weight. Second, they are trying to keep their head down. Doing this, which makes you put your head into your chest turns your chin into a break, causing us to shift our weight incorrectly (causing mishits)! So release the break, and you will be more consistent, not only making solid contact, and hitting not only straighter, but farther!



# FROM THE HILLS

Spring 2024 is here! We are in a mad dash to finish up any remaining projects before we begin the 2024 season. In March we used the tractor deep tines to work new sand deeper into the greens profile. This process also relieves compaction and protects against organic matter layering. In April during our second greens aerification we will be poking holes in the collars and the cleanup areas of the greens. These areas are some of the most difficult areas on the course to manage through the

summer stress so we are hoping an extra round of aerification will help during the summer months.

There have been several nice days in the month of February and even more in March. We continue to educate and communicate the need for assistance in certain matters on the course. One being ball marks. As many courses struggle with this it is an easy task that you should be doing when playing a round. I have attached an image from the USGA with information on how to repair a ball mark properly.



Another yearly communication is at RHCC we keep the rakes in the bunkers. That being said, the way we place the bunker rakes is important. Rake heads should be pointed towards the center of the bunker which would be perpendicular to the edge, not parallel. We are trying to avoid problems as shown in the picture. Bunker rakes allow our mowers to be efficient as well as require our bunker rakers to place each rake correctly after raking the bunker. Please read the information and apply as we can continue to produce the best playing conditions possible!






